**Relief – Child & Youth Workers**

We are seeking qualified relief staff to work at our residential facilities in London and Ailsa Craig. You will be responsible for the support, safety and security of the youth in our care. As a member of a multi-disciplinary team, you will possess the ability to facilitate and motivate youth to work cooperatively, individually or in a group setting. The hourly rate is \$18.12.

**The following is required from the successful candidates:**

- Applicants must provide 8 shifts each month that support a 24 hour per day, 7 day per week work schedule (day, evening, night and weekends). These shifts are not guaranteed.
- Post-secondary education in the human services field (preferred) or equivalent in education & experience.

**If successful, you must provide:**

- A valid full 'G' class Ontario driver's license and have your own reliable transportation (the majority of shifts are at our Ailsa Craig location).
- Current Police Records Check & Vulnerable Position Screening.
- Health Assessment.
- Standard First Aid/CPR Certificate (must obtain within 60 days from your date of hire).
- Be available to complete five (5) days of mandatory agency orientation training.
