Relief – Child & Youth Workers

We are seeking qualified relief staff to work at our residential facilities in London and Ailsa Craig. You will be responsible for the support, safety and security of the youth in our care. As a member of a multi-disciplinary team, you will possess the ability to facilitate and motivate youth to work cooperatively, individually or in a group setting. The hourly rate starts at \$19.60.

The following is required from the successful candidates:

- Applicants must provide support for 24 hours per day, 7 days per week work schedule. Shifts can include day, evenings, nights and weekends
- Preferred post-secondary education in the human services field OR equivalent in education & experience.

If successful, you must provide:

- A valid full 'G' class Ontario driver's license and have your own reliable transportation (the majority of shifts are at our Ailsa Craig location).
- Current Police Records Check & Vulnerable Position Screening
- Health Assessment & Immunizations; Proof of Covid-19 Vaccination(s) or Medical Exemption
- Standard First Aid/CPR Certificate (must obtain within 60 days from your date of hire).
- Be available to complete mandatory agency orientation training.
