- Post-secondary education in Child & Youth Work or equivalent degree/diploma in the Human Services field. (Appropriate combination of education & experience to satisfy the demands of the position.)
- Demonstrated understanding of treatment approaches and/or modalities for work with adolescents.
- Ability to empathize with hard-to-serve adolescents; sincere commitment to serve their needs.
- Demonstrated resiliency and commitment to the core values of the organization.
- Demonstrated competence in clerical tasks, including computer skills.
- Knowledge of safety and security procedures.
- Commitment to maintain and uphold a clean and safe environment.
- Current First Aid, C.P.R. and Crisis Intervention Training certification (preferred).
- Knowledge of CYFSA, YCJA and OH&SA.

- Health assessment with current immunizations including DPT, MMR and COVID vaccination

- Standard First Aid/CPR Level C Certificate (must obtain within 60 days from your date of hire)
- Be available to complete mandatory agency orientation training
